Chris teaches a two week modular course once or twice a year for Asia Biblical Theological Seminary, which is the Asian graduate school for Cornerstone University in Grand Rapids, MI. They also minister to many Filipino students and young career people who now live in their city and attend their church. Currently, five of these Filipinos are taking Bible classes through Anchor Christian University where Chris teaches them.
